With support from the California Arts Council, Create CA, a collective impact coalition, will execute strategies to ensure
every student receives a standards-based high quality arts education in every arts discipline starting in kindergarten and
continuing through high school. These strategies include expansion of the Data Project, widespread adoption of the
Declaration of Student Rights to Equity in Arts Learning, Leadership Development, and implementation of a statewide
Public Will Campaign.
With support from the California Arts Council, Dancers' Group will provide a menu of free programs and services
