This program seeks to specifically address the needs and improve the lives of California's veterans through arts, culture, and creative expression.

The purpose of the Veterans in the Arts program is to increase equity, access, and opportunities for veterans to participate in quality arts programming that is sensitive and responsive to their unique experiences. The program provides project support for nonprofit arts organizations, local arts agencies, veteran's assistance agencies, and social service agencies to reach veterans and their families.
