PROJECT SUPPORT

Arts and Accessibility: Supporting enhanced opportunities for arts participation by people with disabilities.



YOUTH SUPPORT

Artists in Schools: Supporting projects integrating community arts partners as part of the regular school



OPERATIONAL & FIELD SUPPORT

Cultural Pathways: Supporting arts programs in communities of color, recent immigrant and refugee communities, or tribal groups.

Cultural Pathways

Two years of general operating support for arts organizations rooted in communities of color, recent immigrant and refugee communities, or tribal groups.

- Maximum request amount: \$30,000
- Grant Activity Period: July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2022
- Application deadline: November 15, 2019



Intended Outcomes

- Authentic and creative voices of all of California's diverse communities are celebrated and nurtured.
- A greater diversity of artists, organizations and communities across the state are supported.
- Administrative, artistic, and governance personnel receive significant professional development necessary to make transformational growth within their organizations.

Eligibility Requirements

Please review all guidelines carefully for eligibility and program requirements

- California-based arts organizations deeply rooted in and reflective of communities of color, recent immigrant and refugee communities, and tribal or indigenous groups.
- May be a California-based nonprofit arts organization or California-based unincorporated arts organization applying with a Fiscal Sponsor

Eligibility Requirements (cont.)

- Organizations must have a total operating revenue of less than \$150,000 for each of the last two completed fiscal years
- Minimum two-year history of consistent engagement in arts programming and/or services prior to the application deadline
- All applicant organizations must have a principal place of business in California and be accessible to the general public.

Budget Requirements

- Your Cultural Pathways request must be less than 100% of your total operating revenue for the last completed fiscal year
- If applying to multiple CAC grant programs, remember to keep the total grant request amount below 50% of your organization's total operating revenue *per year* of requested funding
- Cultural Pathways does not have a matching fund requirement

Revenue: 2 years, No Match

General Operating Budget (No Match) A balanced budget should be projected and entered for the entire two-year Grant Activity Period. All organizational funds, including CAC projected support, should appear on this budget. The value of any in-kind contributions should be reflected as both revenue and expense. List revenues and expenses in the fields shown, selecting "+" to add additional rows under each category, as necessary. Enter the planned allocation of CAC funds in the CAC Request Amount column. Totals will auto-calculate. Verify that Total Expenses, CAC Request Amount equals the Grant Request Amount provided on the Applicant Information tab. Provide General Operating Budget Notes, if applicable, and select "Save" to return to the application Budget page. 


